Subject: Caltrans' Capital Improvement Projects Update

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Receive and file a status update from Caltrans Representatives on their capital improvement projects on Pacific Coast Highway within the City.

DISCUSSION: Caltrans is responsible for the operation and maintenance of Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) within the City of Malibu. This responsibility also includes the construction of major repairs and improvements, also known as capital improvement projects.
