Subject: Amendment to Professional Services Agreement with Fugro Consultants, Inc.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Authorize the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 2 to the Professional Services Agreement with Fugro Consultants, Inc. (Fugro) to extend the term of the agreement for maintenance and monitoring of the Big Rock Mesa, Malibu Road and Calle Del Barco Landslide Assessment Districts.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action.

WORK PLAN: This item is including in Fiscal Year 2019-2020 City Council Priorities and Departmental Tasks No. 8e approved by Council on June 24, 2019.

DISCUSSION: On August 22, 2016, the Council approved an agreement with Fugro to perform maintenance and monitoring of the Big Rock Mesa, Malibu Road, and Calle Del Barco Landslide Assessment Districts and extended this agreement on July 23, 2018, for one additional year.

Fugro has continued to perform very well during the term of its agreement. Staff recommends executing Amendment No. 2 to their agreement for one additional year.

Staff recommends the City Council approve Amendment No. 2 to Agreement with Fugro.

AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AGREEMENT is made and entered in the City of Malibu on August 12, 2019, by and between the CITY OF MALIBU, hereinafter referred to as City, and Fugro Consultants, Inc., hereinafter referred to as Consultant.

The City and the Consultant agree as follows:

RECITALS

A. On August 22, 2016, the City entered into an Agreement with Consultant for maintenance and monitoring for the Big Rock Mesa, Malibu Road, and Calle Del Barco Landslide Assessment Districts (the "Agreement").

B. On July 23, 2018, City Council approved Amendment No. 1 to extend the term of the Agreement to expire on August 22, 2019.

C. The Parties desire to amend the Agreement to extend the term by one year, to expire on August 22, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of their mutual promises, obligations and covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Section 2.0 – Term of Agreement, is hereby extended to provide that the Agreement will remain in effect until August 22, 2020, unless otherwise terminated or extended as provided in the Agreement.
2. All terms and conditions of the Agreement not amended by this Amendment No. 2 remain in full force and effect.


