Subject: Malibu Disaster Council Composition

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt Resolution No. 19-38 establishing the membership of the Malibu Disaster Council.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action.

WORKPLAN: This task was included as item 1a in the Adopted Workplan for Fiscal Year 2019-2020.

DISCUSSION: According to the City's Emergency Services Organization ordinance (MMC 2.52), the City's Disaster Council was created with the following members: the Mayor, the Director of Emergency Services (City Manager), the Assistant Director of Emergency Services (Public Safety Manager), Chiefs of Emergency Services as identified in the Emergency Operations Plan (Department Heads) and key community representatives appointed by the Director of Emergency Services and approved by the City Council.

The Director of Emergency Services recommends that representatives from the following agencies be appointed to the Disaster Council:

- Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department
- Los Angeles County Fire Department
- California Highway Patrol
- California Department of Transportation
- Los Angeles County Department of Beaches and Harbors
- Los Angeles County Department of Public Works
- Los Angeles County Water District 29
- Santa Monica Malibu Unified School District

- American Red Cross
- Southern California Edison
- Southern California Gas
- United States Coast Guard

RESOLUTION NO. 19-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MALIBU
DESIGNATING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MALIBU DISASTER
COUNCIL

The City Council of the City of Malibu does hereby find, order and resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. Recitals.

- A. According to Chapter 2.52 of the Malibu Municipal Code, which outlines the Emergency Services Organization, Disaster Council membership includes the following representatives: the mayor, the director of emergency services, the assistant director of emergency services, chiefs of emergency services as are provided for in a current emergency plan of the city, and representatives of civic, business, labor, veterans, professional, or other organizations having an official emergency responsibility, as may be appointed by the director with the advice and consent of the City Council.
- B. Chapter 2.52.050 of the Malibu Municipal Code states that the City Manager is the director of emergency services.
- C. The director of emergency services has appointed the following agencies to have representation on the Disaster Council:
 - Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department
 - Los Angeles County Fire Department
 - California Highway Patrol
 - California Department of Transportation
 - Los Angeles County Department of Beaches & Harbors
 - Los Angeles County Department of Public Works
 - Los Angeles County Water District 29
 - Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District
 - American Red Cross
 - Southern California Edison
 - Southern California Gas Company
 - United States Coast Guard
- D. The City Council is committed to establishing a Disaster Council with representation from key emergency response partners in order to improve coordination during emergency planning, preparedness and response operations.

SECTION 2. The City Council advises that the appointments in Section 1(C) be made and consents to such appointments to the Disaster Council.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
