WORK PLAN: This item was not included in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2021-2022. This project is part of normal staff operations.

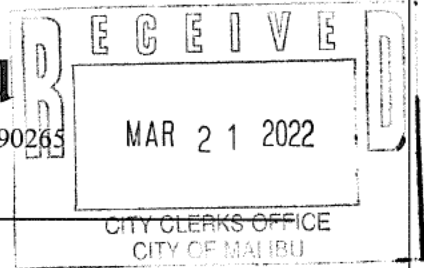
DISCUSSION: On March 18, 2022, the original agenda report was distributed. One additional City Commission/Committee Member Application was received after that time and is attached to this report.
