Subject: Acceptance of Westward Beach Road Shoulder Repair Project

RECOMMENDED ACTION: 1) Accept the work performed by J & H Engineering General Contractors, Inc. for the Westward Beach Road Shoulder Repair Project, Specification No. 2070 as complete; and 2) Authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact with accepting the work complete. Funding for this project is included in the Adopted Budget for FY 2023-24 Account No. 310-9082-5100 (Westward Beach Road Improvements).

WORK PLAN: This item is part of the day-to-day operations identified in the Adopted FY 2023-24 Strategic Priority Project List.

DISCUSSION: On November 13, 2023, City Council awarded the Westward Beach Road Shoulder Repair Project to J & H Engineering General Contractors, Inc. This project included the repair of the southern beachfront shoulder of Westward Beach Road. The asphalt pavement edge had deteriorated over the years. The design followed the direction of the Public Works Commission and City Council to repair the asphalt shoulder, without additional curbs and walkways, as previously proposed. These improvements meet the parking needs while maintaining the rural Malibu aesthetic.

The work is now completed. Staff recommends the City Council to accept the work performed by J & H Engineering General Contractors, Inc. and authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion for the project.

STAFF FOLLOW-UP: Upon acceptance by the City Council of the work associated with this contract, staff will record the Notice of Completion with the Los Angeles County Registrar/Recorder's Office which will allow the City to then release the retention monies following a required 35-day holding period.
