A. Park and City-Owned Vacant Properties Tour
Recommended Action: Tour Parks and City-Owned Vacant Properties and receive updates on park projects by City staff.

Carl Randall indicated support for a dog park at Las Flores Creek Park. He stated eight to 10 people walked their dogs in the park regularly during morning and evening hours.

Carol Randall indicated support for a dog park at Las Flores Creek Park.

Commissioner Guldumann stated the walking path near the Las Flores Creek Park sign could be moved to accommodate a dog park.

Chair Villablanca indicated support for planting additional trees in the park.

John Mazza indicated support for a community center that would accommodate a library and community rooms. He stated an aquatics facility could be built on the property.

Community Services Director Bobbett stated two acres of the property were purchased with Los Angeles County Measure R funds and would need to be used for transportation-related purposes.

Commissioner Guldemann stated the property could be a community park, maker's space, and have walking trails.

Sandy Glover stated pollinator plants were recently installed at the park.

Chair Villablanca indicated support for planting additional trees at the dog park.
