SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Commission Assignments

At its Regular meeting on June 13, 2022, the City Council approved the following assignments for the Public Works Commission in Fiscal Year 2022-2023:

1. Review and make recommendations to the City Council on Capital Improvement and Disaster Projects
2. Review and make recommendations to the City Council for an updated five-year Capital Improvement Projects Plan
3. Report on the status of Los Angeles County Waterworks, District 29 infrastructure and make recommendations toward long-term solutions
4. Review utility undergrounding options within the City
5. Review parking issues citywide
6. Review and make recommendations to the City Council regarding the City's public encroachment policy
7. Review the maintenance and monitoring of the City's landslide assessment districts
8. Review and make recommendations on the Pavement Management Plan
9. Review the operation and maintenance of the Civic Center Water Treatment Plant
10. Review and make recommendations on offsite Private Development mitigation measures that are constructed within the public right-of-way
11. Work with Caltrans on a large redesign of Pacific Coast Highway over a long-term period of time
12. Incorporate discussion of alternative transportation modes, such as bike lanes, in all road improvement projects
13. Make bimonthly oral reports to the City Council on Commission activity
14. Submit a mid-year written report to the City Council on Commission activities
