State Law:

Swimming Pool Safety Act of 2006 (Assembly Bill 2977)
Effective January 1, 2007


California Health and Safety Code Section 115928(d) provides: "Whenever a building permit is issued for the remodel or modification of a single family home with an existing swimming pool, toddler pool, or spa, the permit shall require that the suction outlet of the existing swimming pool, toddler pool, or spa be upgraded so as to be equipped with an anti-entrapment cover meeting the current standards of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) or the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME)."

This State law requires that when a building permit is issued for the remodel or modification of a single-family home, or for a new or remodeled swimming pool or spa, the permit shall require the installation of an anti-entrapment cover on the suction outlet of the pool or spa located on that property. The anti-entrapment cover must meet ASTM or ASME standards.

Examples of anti-entrapment drain cover devices for existing pools:



Note: Some device installations may require the pool to be empty.

Anti-entrapment covers are available at pool equipment suppliers.

Permits will be issued upon receipt of an affidavit regarding compliance with this law. Final approval of permits will not be given until compliance is verified by the City of Malibu.

California Health and Safety Code Section 115928(d) provides: "Whenever a building permit is issued for the remodel or modification of a single family home with an existing swimming pool toddler pool or spa, the permit shall require that the suction outlet of the existing swimming pool toddler pool, or spa be upgraded so as to be equipped with an anti-entrapment cover meeting the current standards of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) or the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME)."

Inspection

Secure installation of the device shall be demonstrated in the presence of the building inspector. A push test using a pool brush/telepole to show the device is properly attached to the suction outlet is an acceptable method.

Manufacturer's information or packaging showing the installed device meets ASTM or ASME standards shall be provided to the building inspector for verification.
