Re: Actions from the July 9, 2018 Malibu City Council Regular meeting

At the City Council Regular meeting on Monday, July 9, 2018, the Council took the actions listed below with follow-up by various staff members shown in parentheses:

- 1) Allowed and approved warrant demand numbers 53901-54031 listed on the register from the General Fund and directed the City Manager to pay out the funds to each of the claimants listed in Warrant Register No. 620 in the amount of the warrant appearing opposite their names, for the purposes stated on the respective demands in a total amount of \$1,781,507.35. City of Malibu payroll check numbers 4930-4934 and ACH deposits were issued in the amount of \$202,447.05. (Administration)
- 2) Approved the minutes for the June 11, 2018 Malibu City Council Regular meeting (City Clerk)
- 3) Approved the updated 2018 Calendar of City Council meetings, moving the September 12, 2018 Adjourned Regular City Council meeting to September 11, 2018. (City Clerk)
- 4) Continued the hearing to September 11, 2018, and directed staff to return with an ordinance to establish provisions to regulate short-term rentals of property citywide revised to limit onstreet parking to a maximum of one car when no onsite parking is available, an ordinance effective date of six months after the second reading and adoption, and to provide options for a primary residence requirement and potential exemptions, options for limiting short-term rental permitting to one permit per property, per individual or per Assessor Parcel Number, information on the location, ownership, zoning and other characteristics of the City's multifamily unit inventory and options for allowing some portion of multifamily units to be used for short-term rentals except for condominiums, information about septic requirements for units rented on a short-term basis, options for the timing of processing permit renewals (such as on a rolling basis or with a set renewal deadline annually), options for noticing communities with CC&Rs of a short-term rental permit application and specifying a deadline to object, options for requiring removal of illegal listings from online platforms, and information on short-term rental permit fees (City Manager/Planning)

- 5) Adopted Resolution No. 18-47 authorizing a reward in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for information leading to the apprehension, identification, arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Tristan Beaudette in Malibu Creek State Park on June 22, 2018 (City Manager)
