County	Public Health	Can provide vital records for those born outside of the country
County	Public Social Services	Assist with food stamps (alFresh) and expedited registration for MediCal eligibility.
County	Public Works	Building & Safety; Road Maintenance and Water Resources
County	Regional Planning	Long range planning, land development counseling, project/case intake and processing, environmental review and zoning enforcement
County	Registrar Recorder/County Clerk	Assist in replacing vital records such as birth certificates.

Federal	Internal Revenue Service	Federal Tax Information related to disaster and loss

Non-Profit	Salvation Army	Provide access to education, workforce training and opportunities for youth and families.
Non-Profit	Neighborhood Legal Services	Free assistance to survivors.
State	CA Department of Public Health	Vital Records for outside the County
State	Contractors State License Board	Information and resources to help and protect contractors and consumers
State	Department of Motor Vehicles	Assistance with identification and lost documentation
State	California Governor's Office of Emergency Services	Provide preparedness information to protect lives and property, build capabilities, and support our communities for a resilient California .
State	Franchise Tax Board	Assistance with tax assessments for impacted residents
State	Department of Social Services (SSGP)	State Supplemental Grant Program, which provides grant funds to assist people who have suffered damage in a disaster area
