SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON VEGETATION MANAGEMENT

City staff and the Assistant City Attorney participated in a conference call with Southern California Edison (SCE) and the County of Los Angeles to discuss the proposed SCE's Vegetation Management Program. SCE is completing its survey of trees and has agreed to provide the City and the County with the list of trees to be cut when the survey is done. The City continues to coordinate with SCE to ensure it does not violate the Local Coastal Program's (LCP) native tree and Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Area (ESHA) protections. The City is also coordinating with the LA County Planning Department.

At the Regular meeting on April 16, 2019, the Malibu Parks and Recreation Commission discussed potential locations for a skate park in Malibu. The Commission reviewed and discussed vacant properties currently owned by the City and recommended the Case property next to Bluffs Park as the most appropriate site. The recommendation will be presented to the Council at a future meeting when the item is agendaized for discussion.

ANNUAL CITY TREE MAINTENANCE

The City received four proposals for the Annual City Tree Maintenance. Staff is evaluating the proposals and will be bringing an item to City Council.

ANNUAL STREET MAINTENANCE PROJECT

Street resurfacing on City streets was completed last week in the Rambla Vista and Big Rock neighborhoods, Las Flores Canyon Road, Carbon Canyon Road, and Malibu Road. Next week, the contractor will be performing road striping.

SANDBAGS

All plastic sandbags on City property have been picked up throughout the City, including all canyon roads.

PCH MEDIAN PROJECT

Caltrans will be grinding the trenches on PCH by Malibu Seafood on Thursday and Friday, April 25 and 26 from 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM. Final striping will be scheduled next week.

FARMER'S MARKET DURING SMC CONSTRUCTION

The City will work with the Cornucopia Foundation, which operates the Malibu Farmers Market, and the County to process a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) amendment application to address the temporary changes to the market (including displaced parking) during construction of the Santa Monica College Satellite Campus and the final permanent market configuration and operation after construction is finished.

LCP PUBLIC ACCESS MAP UPDATE AND 2015 LCP HOUSING ELEMENT UPDATE

The California Coastal Commission (CCC) will consider these two amendments on Thursday May 9 at their meeting in Oxnard. City staff has been working closely with CCC staff to try to adjust their suggested modifications to suit the City's needs as much as possible. MRCA / WINDING WAY PORTABLE RESTROOM

The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) is processing a Coastal Development Permit (CDP) application to allow placement of a portable restroom at the Escondido Canyon Falls trailhead on Winding Way. Once the application has been deemed complete, a public hearing before the Planning Commission will be scheduled.

MRCA / LECHUZA BEACH ACCESS PROJECT

The MRCA Board will consider for adoption the Initial Study/Negative Declaration for this project on Wednesday, May 1 at 2:00 PM. The City sent an additional comment letter on April 22 pertaining to management of the beach access.
