RADICAL BEAUTY ART EXHIBITION – SAVE THE DATE

The Community Services Department received 101 applications from artists to display their artwork in the upcoming *Radical Beauty: Malibu Rising* Art Exhibition at City Hall. Each applicant was allowed to submit up to 10 pieces of art in any medium inspired by the Woolsey Fire. The submissions were reviewed by the Cultural Arts Commission City Hall Art Exhibition Ad Hoc Committee, who selected 60 artists whose work will be featured in the exhibition. The exhibition opens with a free public reception in City Hall on Wednesday, May 22, 6:30 PM to 8:00 PM.

SENIOR CENTER PROGRAMS AND EVENTS

The Senior Center Photo Portrait Painting Workshop took place on Monday, May 6 at Malibu Bluffs Park. Participants brought in a photo of their choice and learned painting techniques related to classical portrait painting, limited pallet, shadow pattern, and site-size.
