### MALIBU REBUILDS - REBUILD COORDINATOR AVAILABLE TO ASSIST WITH POST-WOOLSEY FIRE REBUILD PROJECTS

As part of the City's ongoing efforts to assist property owners whose homes were damaged or destroyed by the Woolsey Fire, a new Building Plan Check coordination service is now offered to applicants. The Rebuild Coordinator is available to meet in person at City Hall to assist property owners and their representatives with securing approvals of building plans from all City Departments and outside agencies after projects have been approved by Planning. The Rebuild Coordinator will also assist in completing all construction permit applications upon approval of building plans. The Rebuild Coordinator is available Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM to meet with applicants and to make appointments for them to meet one-on-one with City Department specialists. ## GUARDRAIL REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Guardrail Replacement Project consists of replacement of the damaged guardrails from the Woolsey Fire at various locations within the City. The project schedule is September to October, Monday to Friday, 6:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The installation of the new guardrails will require temporary lane closures. One travel lane will be open at all times.

### Locations

- Encinal Canyon (between Avenida Del Mar and Avenida De La Encinal)
- Birdview Avenue (between Westward Beach Road and Bluewater Road)
- Wildlife Road (between Zumirez Drive and Selfridge Street)
- Latigo Canyon (between PCH and Ocean View Drive)
- Corral Canyon (between PCH and Seabreeze Drive)

## PCH PAVEMENT PROJECT (CALTRANS)

This Caltrans project consists of making pavement repairs and applying a slurry seal treatment on PCH from the McClure Tunnel in Santa Monica to the Malibu Lagoon Bridge. Caltrans will be applying a slurry seal treatment on PCH from Tuesday, September 17 through October 17, 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM. During this time, one travel lane will be closed.
