City of Malibu Declares State of Emergency

(Malibu, CA) – In an Executive Order in her role as Director of Emergency Services, City Manager Reva Feldman today issued a Declaration of Local Emergency regarding the Coronavirus / COVID-19.

The declaration was based on the rapidly evolving challenges to protect public health and safety related to the spread of COVID-19. The City joins the State of California, County of Los Angeles, and many other cities in taking this step. President Trump also declared a National Emergency on Friday.

The emergency proclamation will be considered for ratification by the City Council at a Special meeting on Monday, March 16. The proclamation enables the City to take additional legal, operational, and recovery measures that may be needed to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic that is affecting communities in Los Angeles County, throughout the state, and across the nation.
