
Approval of a Resolution for the City of Malibu's allocation of Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds from the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) to support recovery from the 2018 presidentially declared disaster (DR-4407).

The Council will consider the following allocation:

The use of \$18,602,848.07 in CDBG-DR funds allocated to the City through HCD's Disaster Recovery Multifamily Housing Program to assist with meeting the unmet rental housing need, including the needs of individuals displaced from rental homes and individuals who became homeless as the result of the disasters.
