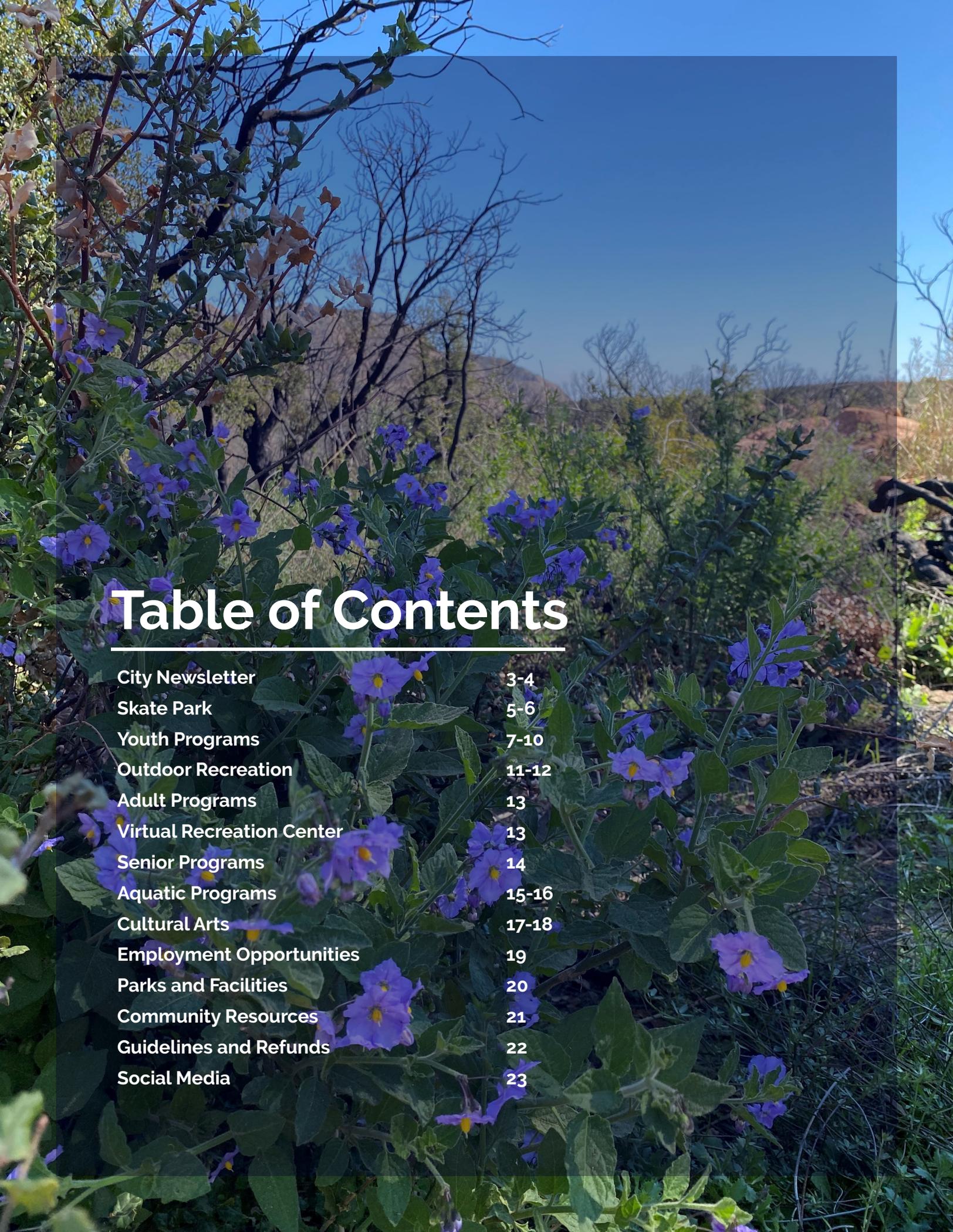

MALIBU BLUFFS PARK WORKOUT STATION

The City is installing a workout station at Malibu Bluffs Park to offer community members a free, fun, outdoor fitness option. The existing zip-line play structure was removed and the new workout station includes a poured-in-place rubber surface, signage, and exercise equipment. The workout station is expected to open in April 2021.



HYBRID COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING

Are you prepared for a disaster? Do you know how to help yourself, your family, and your community in an emergency? Would you like to learn? Join Malibu's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT).

Due to COVID-19, the CERT program is shifting to a hybrid online based model, consisting of both online and hands-on training. Participants will take the online classroom portion of the course at home, at their own pace. Once participants have completed the online section, they are eligible to take the in-person training portion including: disaster medical, how to use a fire extinguisher, light search and rescue, disaster psychology, and CERT's role in a disaster. Participants will complete a drill to display their skills in these areas.

Classes will be instructed by the City of Malibu Public Safety Office, Malibu CERT Team members, and the Los Angeles County Fire Department. Graduates will receive a backpack with basic disaster preparedness supplies.

FIGHTING CLIMATE CHANGE

The City is preparing for the implementation of Senate Bill 1383. By 2025, California must reduce organic waste disposal by 75% and rescue at least 20% of the edible food currently thrown out. To meet this target, the City will facilitate organic waste collection services for residents and businesses, establish an edible food recovery program, and conduct research and education by 2022.

Organic waste in the landfill emits 20% of the State's methane, a climate super pollutant 84 times more potent than carbon dioxide. Malibu residents can help reach the goal by minimizing waste and combating climate change by reducing, reusing, and recycling organic waste. MalibuCity.org/VirtualEnviro

SKATE PARK GUIDELINES

Skateboarding, in-line skating, and scootering are hazardous activities. Any person utilizing the skate park does so at their own risk.

Any person using the Skate Park must wear a face covering, helmet, elbow pads, and knee pads. Any person failing to wear required safety equipment will be subject to a citation (MMC 12.08.250)

HOW TO MAKE A RESERVATION

Registration is available seven days in advance. Visit MalibuCity.org/SkatePark and click on "Temporary Skate Park". Registration opens each night at midnight for the following week. A maximum of two reservations may be made with one email address, per 24 hours.

- Click on "Online Reservation System"
- Sign in to create a profile by using Google, Facebook, or by entering manually
- Select desired date and time
- Maximum of 16 participants per two hour session

- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult
- Bicycles and motorized equipment are prohibited
- Skating on park curbs, parking lot, and pedestrian walkways is prohibited
- Spectators are not permitted in the designated skate area
- No food, drink, or glass allowed in the designated skate area
- No intimidation, bullying, fighting or reckless behavior
- Animals must be on a leash and remain outside of the facility and in control of their owner at all times
- All general park rules apply

PERMANENT SKATE PARK

In 2019, the City Council approved the use of the Crummer/Case property adjacent to Malibu Bluffs Park as the location for a temporary skate park, and authorized staff to release a Request for Proposals for the design of a 12,500 square-foot permanent skate park. The City selected California Skate Parks as the design consultant. After two virtual public design meetings and a community survey, a preliminary design was completed for Commission and Council approval.

The Parks and Recreation Commission approved the Preliminary Design for the Permanent Skate Park at their Regular Meeting on November 17, 2020, and approved facility amenities, including benches, native plants, trash cans, signage, and public art.

The Preliminary Design was reviewed by the Public Works Commission at their Special Meeting on March 2, 2021. The Planning Commission and City Council will review the project in mid-2021.

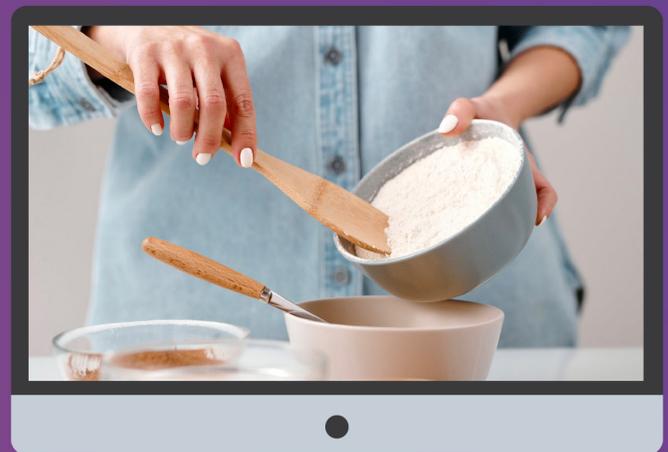

COMMUNITY POOL GUIDELINES

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Malibu Community Pool is open with limited hours and capacity.

- Do not enter the pool if you are sick or have a fever
- Maintain physical distance of 6 feet apart at all times
- Face coverings are required, except while in the water
- Swimmers are required to shower before entering
- Swimmer must promptly exit at the end of their swim
- No observers allowed on deck
- No shared items
- The pool will be monitored for compliance



SEAWOLVES SWIM TEAM - SEALIONS

Ages 9 - 12

Sealions swimmers must be able to swim 100 yards freestyle in 2 minutes or less and 25 yards of backstroke or breaststroke across the pool. Swimmers will be instructed in all four main swimming strokes, breathing techniques, and skill specific drills including tailored kick and pull sets.

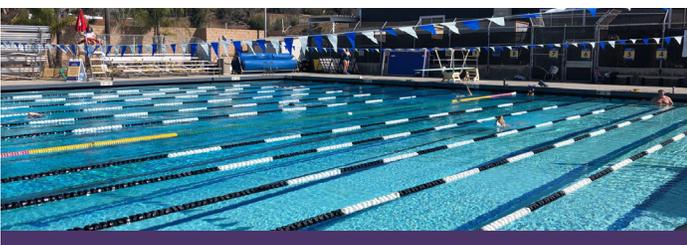
