 - Time deferrals


Hybrid Meetings

- Councilmember Participation
 - AB 361 allows Councilmembers to participate remotely
- Policy Considerations
 - Disruptions for remote participants
 - Power or internet outages within city-limits, storm, fire or other similar events
 - Technical issues specific to City Hall

Commissions

- Provide direction on the meeting format for:
 - Planning Commission
 - All other Boards, Commissions, and Committees
