

ACTIVITY REPORT FOR JANUARY 2024
MALIBU**

SCHOOL ISSUES

Contacted a subject and parents at their Agoura residence regarding a Malibu HS burglary incident. Follow-up investigations regarding a battery incident at Malibu HS.

INTERVENTIONS

COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

1. The J-Team received reports from concerned citizens and parents regarding various juvenile issues in the community. We provided them with information about available resource programs in our community.
2. We inquired with the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney regarding the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
3. Throughout the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to keep her up to date regarding our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues within the city.
4. The J-Team entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion program for various violations.
5. We investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office. Additionally, we assisted other investigators in the preparation of cases for court.
6. The J-Team met with narcotic detectives at the station to discuss information regarding juvenile and drug-related issues.
7. Various juvenile referrals were brought to our attention for processing and follow-up related to their contacts with uniformed personnel.
8. During weekend evenings, we conducted our routine checks of areas known to have problems with juvenile delinquency and responded to calls related to juvenile activity.
9. Assisted patrol regarding CARP, backfilled behind patrol shortages and worked mandatory overtime.
10. We conducted a monthly sex offender 290 registration within the jurisdiction of Malibu.
11. A report was taken for the battery incident at Malibu HS and submitted to Sylmar for filing considerations.
12. The patrol vehicles have been equipped with the latest School Critical Information booklets.
