



MALIBU COMMUNITY LAND

The City of Malibu currently owns five parcels of vacant land spanning just over 61 acres. To ensure the future of these community lands aligns with the community's priorities, the City of Malibu is launching a robust outreach and engagement program to collect your feedback.

Throughout this process, the City's primary goal is to gather extensive input on what types of public facilities the community prefers for these five spaces. Your feedback will help ensure the future facilities address long-term needs and aspirations of the entire Malibu community.

The City invites the community to share their valuable insights and ideas regarding the future development of five properties. Your input and participation will help shape the future of Malibu.

Malibu is committed to inclusivity and equity in community decision-making and recognizes that a lot of things may have changed since the last survey that was done over a decade ago. The City has developed an innovative outreach program designed to engage a diverse cross-section of the community.

The City anticipates the outreach and engagement program will span approximately six months (April through October).



The City of Malibu partnered with Managed Career Solutions to provide a grant funded work force development opportunity and a park improvement opportunity for Legacy Park. Work began on October 7, 2023, with crews clearing over two acres of nonnative, invasive plants and one and a half acres of overgrown native plants, all at no cost to the City.

The crew culminated the work by planting 460 native pollinator plants and flowering shrubs. The grant ended on February 28, 2024. All work followed the City's strict Earth Friendly Management Policy focusing on a more sustainable and beautiful future for all Malibu residents.






