Coastal Development Permit – Posting of Subject Property

For all Coastal Development Permit projects, the property must be posted with a *laminated* “Notice of a Request for a Coastal Development Permit” which will be provided to the applicant sometime during the review of proposed development.

The Notice must be posted and a completed Affidavit of Posting (see reverse) must be returned to the Planning Department prior to the project being deemed complete. The Notice must remain in place until after the appeal period for the project has expired.

The Notice shall be posted in a conspicuous location on the property that is visible by the public. The Notice may be mounted to the exterior of the building, mailbox, fences, or mounted on a stake for those properties which are vacant.

A photograph must be taken of the sign and affixed to the Affidavit of Posting. Please make sure that the photograph is taken from a wide enough angle to allow the case planner to discern where the photograph was taken. For developed properties, a good sign location is near the address numbers on the structure. A close up photograph of the sign will not be accepted.
